EASTERN.

Yellow Fever Reports—Here and
Elsewhere—Ratons for the Week
End.

Memphis, Tenn., 5.—Twenty-
two physicians of the Howard
corps report 105 new cases.

Vicksburg, 5.—Four deaths. The
fever has greatly abated, but the
cases in the city are very few, but
are increasing rapidly in the
country.

La Fourche Crossing, 5.—No new
cases. All the sick are doing well.

Thibodaux, La., 5.—Eighteen
new cases and two deaths for the
past twenty-four hours. Total cases,
24; total deaths, 25. This report
does not include the cases in the
country.

Donaldsonville, 5.—Total cases,
115; new cases, 15; deaths, 15.
The fever has greatly abated, but
the cases in the city are very few,
but are increasing rapidly in the
country.

Memphis, Tenn., 5.—The weather
indicates a storm, with cold wind
from the north, which will be un-
favorable to the sick.

There has been unusual activity in the How-
ard association headquarters during
the day, and the fever continues
spreading.

The board of health report 28 deaths in the city,
during the past twenty-four hours, ending
at 6 o'clock to-night.

The undertakers report the burial of 28
others, who died outside the cor-
poration line.

Washington, 5.—The secretary of
