FOREIGN.

CROWN OF GREAT BRITAIN.

Riot at Limerick.

LONDON, 2d.—A serious riot occurred at Limerick yesterday. A mob of thousand persons attacked a party of militia, the police defended the latter, and were stoned by the rioters; reinforcements arrived from the stations and the riot was finally suppressed after a considerable number had been injured.

FRANCE.

BUSINESS IN THE ASSEMBLY—ENTERTAINING THE PILGRIMS.

PARIS, 31.—The Assembly has settled upon the following as the order in which the reports of business before it will be taken up first: first, the municipal electoral bill; second, the municipal organization bill; third, the general electoral bill.

The Catholic Club in this city has been entertaining the pilgrims from the United States.

MORE MUZZLING OF THE PRESS—PRINCE NAPOLEON NOMINATED.

The sale and circulation of the *Soleil* newspaper has been prohibited in several of the departments.

Prince Napoleon has been nominated for the Assembly in the department of the Charente Inférieure and Seine.

DISSOLUTION DETERMINED ON—INSTINCTED BY THE CARLISTS.

At a meeting of the left, today, it was resolved that a motion for the dissolution of the Assembly should be carried, and that overtures should be made to other organizations of the chamber to secure co-operation in the movement.

RAYONNE, 31.—Hernani is completely invested by the Carlists who have had some sharp skirmishes with the garrison.

PRUSSIA—DISMISSED HUMORS—BISMARCK RECEIVING.

BRUSSELS, 31.—The rumors that Germany seeks to disturb the Luxembourg treaty, and to revive the candidature of a German prince for the Spanish throne, which have been for some days in circulation throughout Europe, are considered here to be wholly without foundation.

Prince Bismarck is slowly recovering his health on his estates at Varsa.

SPAIN.

GONE FOR ESCAPED CONVICTS.

MADRID, 1.—A Spanish frigate has gone to Oran, Algiers, to take on board the convicts escaped from Cartagena, at the time of the suppression of the insurrection.

BODY OF CARLISTS DISPERSED.

The national forces entered Chiva, dispersing a body of 4,000 Carlists.

CROWN OF GREAT BRITAIN.

A BIG REVOLT.

LONDON, 1.—A Melrose dispatch says that twelve thousand of the inhabitants of Fez have revolted, in consequence of the reimposition of the gate tax. All business had stopped at that moment, but the tax has been all off fighting, and it was hoped the Sultan would yield to the people, and remove the objectionable tax.

Rain in India.

The Vicerey of India telegraphs that rain has been general north of the Ganges, and that portions of the country south of the river have also been visited with rain. Fears of further distress are measurably allayed.

MOTIONS REJECTED.

In the House of Commons this evening, a motion, by Sir H. Wolf, to reduce the salary of the British Minister at Washington, to five thousand dollars, was rejected, 80 to 2.

A PRINCE SHOT AT.

As Prince Saxe Weimar was leaving his residence this afternoon, to attend a levee, he was fired at by an unknown assassin, who escaped; the prince was unharmed. He had previously received threatening letters, as had also the Duke of Cambridge and Disraeli.

FRANCE.

Escaped from New Caledonia.

PARIS, 1.—Intelligence has been received that a Communité colonel, who was sent to New Caledonia, has escaped.

MEETING OF LEFT CENTRE.

The Left Centre, at a meeting to-day, took action toward an alliance with the Right Centre; a motion was carried to demand the establishment of a republican government, which all the members of the Left will sign in hope that the Right Centre will support it when submitted to the Assembly.

RESSED BY THE CARLISTS.

BAYONNE, 1.—The town of Hernani has been pressed by Carlists. The Republican community requires reinforcements. Gen. Loma, with the 1st corps of the army of the north, joined Concha's command at Miranda.

AUSTRALIA.

Shipwreck and Loss of Life.

MELBOURNE.—The ship *British Admiral*, from Liverpool to Melbourne, was totally wrecked on King's Island; she had forty-five passengers and thirty-eight crew. Four passengers and five seamen escaped.
