CONGRESSIONAL.

SENATE.

WASHINGTON, 14.—The Vice
President returned and resumed
the chair. He presented a memo-
rial asking that the papers in the
case of the Kansas senatorial election
be taken from the files and re-
ferred to the committee on elec-
tions.

Chandler offered a resolution au-
thorizing the committee on com-
merce to sit during the recess to in-
vestigate the subject of sub-
sidies, and what lines
should be subsidized, also into the
propriety of granting bounties to
ship builders, and the like. It was
referred to the Senate Committee on
Commerce.

Harrison moved to adjourn.

It was agreed that the resolu-
tion would be over, and suggested
that it be modified so as to include
the Pacific coast, where there is the
finest navigation in the world.

The resolution lie over.

Anthony submitted a resolution,
which lies over, reciting a resolution
reported at the late session, for
expulsion of T. W. Patterson, to
the Senate to consider, and to con-
sider the same for want of time;
also saying that it is questionable
whether the resolution could
now be considered, inasmuch as Pat-
terson is no longer a member, and
therefore declaring the failure of
the Senate to act upon said resolu-
tion, is not to be interpreted as an
approval or disapproval of the same,
and that Patterson have never
made a written application for pub-
lication in the congressional record.

Hoover again sought to have some
petitions received.

Sherman opposed petition seek-
ing legislation, but had no objection
to receiving and filing them in
in the Senate.

Anthony thought they might
take the most liberal construction
and receive petitions, though not
to appear before the Senate.

Hoover cited precedents to show
that petitions had heretofore been
read and referred. After further
debate the Senate did not re-
ceive petitions by a vote of 24
against 32.

The resolution in the Caldwell
case was rescinded.

Merrill, of Vt., argued the right
of the Senate to give up the rights
of the State to take action in
this case proposed by the resolution
of the committee, and declared the
Senate was bound by every senti-
ment of truth and justice to see
that the seats shall not be made
vacant by any means, as far as
possible.

The Health Board has caused an
examination of the Tomb.

In the case to recover the first
award for widening the canal,
Judge Chapman, of U. S. Court of
Claims, affirmed the constitutionality
of the act of 1871, and the second
