New York, May 2.—Brig. Gen. Bell, who has just arrived in Washington, has just returned in the Philippines, where he directed in command of four departments of Luzon.

One-sixth of the natives of Luzon have either been killed or have died of the dense fever in the last two years. The loss of life by killing has been very great, but I think that not one man has been slain except where his death served the legitimate purposes of war.
