LOCAL BRIEFS.

Butter has fallen one cent wholesale, and is now selling at 20 cents.

Active work has begun holding the steel columns into position in the basement of the new Y. M. C. A. building, so that the first floor may be laid.

Edwin L. Heal, a well known resident of Park City, died yesterday of consumption, leaving a wife and two sons. The funeral will be held tomorrow at Park City.

Annual examinations in the Murray, Sandy and Bingham schools are being held today and will continue tomorrow, under the direction of the county board of examiners.

The directors of the D. A. M. society are meeting this afternoon to arrange for calling for bids on the steel work of the new building for the state fair grounds.

The Provo Elks have issued press passes for the approaching state convention, which gives the holders freedom of anything and everything in that part of the state.

Today is payday for the department employees of the city for the first half of May. The total amount of the payrolls, which are being paid by City Treasurer Harris, is \$9,207.25.

There is an annual examination for gunners in progress at Fort Douglas, with 100 candidates. First class gunners receive an additional pay of \$2 per month, and second class gunners \$1 per month.

The Salt Lake public library will be closed from May 21 to June for the purpose of taking the annual inventory and all books now out must be returned on or before May 21. No books will be given out at the library after May 18.

State Supt. of Schools Nelson will go to Springfield on Friday and deliver an address to the high school graduates of that city and on Saturday he will attend the graduating exercises of the Boxelder county schools at Brigham City.

The Twenty-ninth U. S. Infantry has arrived from the Philippines Islands, and is quartered at the Presidio, preparatory to removal to the department of the Colorado for station. The five companies assigned to Fort Douglas will arrive the last of the coming week.

Dr. L. H. Worthington of Grand Junction, Colo., lectured Monday evening at the home of Mrs. M. A. Armstrong, 729 east Third South street, on electro-magnetism. By request the doctor will repeat his talk, with demonstrations, on Monday, the 23rd inst.

Isadore Miller, the man arrested at Brigham City yesterday for the Salt Lake police, charged with stealing about \$50 worth of goods from the Edwards Commission company, was brought back to this city this morning by Capt. Burdick, who went after the man last night.

The visiting state engineers organized an association yesterday afternoon, to be called the Association of State Engineers, with Mr. Dornhaus of Utah as temporary chairman, and Mr. Johnson, of Wyoming, as temporary secretary.

The second meeting of the association will be held at Boise, Idaho, where a permanent organization will be effected.

Unknown parties are putting in circulation in this city a silver certificate which have been raised to \$10 certificates. The work is poorly done, and careful examination detects the fraud.

MUCH SIGNING TO DO.

Many Bonds to be Signed by Mayor Morris and Recorder Critchlow.

Mayor Morris and City Recorder Critchlow will have an opportunity to display their penmanship for the next few weeks by signing up all the city's refunding bonds which arrived today from the east for the signatures of the mayor and city recorder. The bonds refunded are an issue of the total sum of \$548,000, the contract for the refunding of which has been awarded to E. H. Rollins & Sons, of Denver. There are 5,480 bonds of the amount of \$1,000 each.

The mayor and recorder must accordingly sign their names 5,480 times to complete the signing of the bonds, at a fair rate a person can sign and blot about four per minute and at that rate it will take the officials 28 hours and 10 minutes to do the work. Should they put in two hours each day of the job it will take them just 14 days to complete it. After the bonds are signed they will be returned to Rollins & Sons.

"THE WATER WE DRINK."

Condition of the Supply from Parley's Canyon at the Joint Building.

Engineer Lawrence today cleaned out the screen in the watermain which supplies the city and county building with water, and the collection of trash which had accumulated there was amazing. The screen is composed of three sections through which the water has to pass before it enters the pipes in the building, and it catches nearly all of the debris and prevents it from choking up the pipes throughout the building. The cleaning out today of the screen showed that the water of Parley's creek is in a very bad condition and should be thoroughly filtered before being used in households at all.

It was stated by the engineer today that the screen, which is his own property, often catches frogs, angle worms, cigar and cigarette stamps which would otherwise circulate through the pipes in the building and cause much annoyance by choking up the pipes. The screen was cleaned out once or twice a week during this season of the year, and was not in as bad condition today as it has been on previous occasions.

However it is an object lesson to any one who saw it and impresses one with the necessity of filtering the water before using it for any purpose whatever.

BAD WRECK IN EAST WYOMING.

Burlington Billings Line the Scene of Worst Smashup of Recent Years

ONE KILLED, SEVERAL INJURED.

Brake Beam Dropped to the Track Derailing the Smoker and Causing Accident.

(Special to the "News.")

Cheyenne, Wyo., May 18.—One of the worst wrecks that has occurred in recent years on the Burlington's Billings line occurred at 6:30 last night near Moorcroft, east of Sheridan.

A brake beam fell to the track and derailed the smoker and chair cars.

George H. Carpenter of Cody, Wyo., was killed and several passengers received cuts and bruises.

The track was torn up and traffic delayed for several hours.

ANOTHER ACCOUNT.

Moorcroft, Wyo., May 18.—An east-bound Burlington train was wrecked three miles east of here by the spreading of rails and George Carpenter of Cody was killed. A number of delegates on their way to the state convention at Laramie were injured, but not seriously. The road will be blocked until late today.
