Editor Deseret News:

I am living on a farm about three

miles southwest from Blackfoot town,

close to Snake River. The land on

which I live is very good, of a rich

sandy loam, with now and then a

gravelly spot. The land is mostly

covered with a growth of rabbit brush.

The country is a large flat of

about 20 miles long and 10 or 15

miles wide. A few slow

moving creeks flow through it, and

carrying water all the year, traverse

the land in a westerly direction.

From these sloughs water can easily

be brought onto the land for irrigation.

Food is very scarce, but is close

to an abundance of feed north of this

land. There are two or three cedars

in great abundance, or southwest,

where lays an extended grass bottom.

The timber here is mostly of the

country cottonwood, and that is the
