LOCAL BRIEFS.

Pardon Board Meeting.—The State board of pardon is in session today at the state prison.

Accounts Audited.—The general accounts of the G. A. R., Spanish War Veterans and Women's Relief corps met last night in the Federal building and settled all bills connected with the Lincoln day exercises in Army hall.

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CITY ENGINEER SUBMITS REPORT

Many Recommendations for Further Improvement Are Made by Kelsey.

SUMMARY OF EXPENDITURES

Storm Sewer and Comfort Stations Are Urged as Immediate Necessities.
—Filtration Plant Needed.

In his annual report which will be submitted to Mayor Bransford, City Engineer Kelsey makes numerous recommendations and gives estimates on the work completed in the last year. The public improvements which were made for the year ending on Dec. 31, 1908, cost the city and property owners \$87,682.33. His department alone cost the city \$90,021.92. The estimates on the summary of improvements contemplated this year amount to \$2,438,538.97. The following recommendations are made:

"That the city open without delay, negotiations with the owners of water rights in Big Cottonwood, Little Cottonwood and Mill Creek canyons, and that where reasonable terms can be obtained, contracts be at once entered into for the purchase of or exchange for the waters of these streams."

"That immediately following any favorable action of the court with regard to the right to enlarge the East Jordan canal that the work of construction be pushed to completion, and that the attorney having in charge the construction proceedings be instructed to obtain an action of the court as soon as possible."

"That a filtration plant be installed in connection with the present waterworks system."

"That in the interest of cleanliness, health, fire protection and the maintenance of suitable water pressure in the water mains a distributing reservoir of not less than 1,000,000 gallons capacity be constructed above Mill Creek, and that the distribution of the waters of Big Cottonwood and Parley's canyons be made."

"That in consideration of the rapidly increasing demand made on the water mains of the upper distributing system taking water from City creek, and the utter impossibility of properly supplying these mains under the present conditions, a reservoir of not less than five million gallons capacity be constructed at the intake of the high line and connecting with the Twentieth ward system, such a reservoir would afford protection against fire in any part of the city."

"That the proposed storage reservoir near the forks of Parley's canyon be constructed."

"That to enable an accurate measurement to be made of the waters received in the distributing system from Big Cottonwood and Parley's creeks, automatic registering water gauges be installed in the creek immediately below the reservoir."

"That an automatic registering weir be installed in City creek below the brick tank to determine accurately the overflow at that point."

"That in consideration of the rapidly increasing demand for relief from the inconvenience and destruction caused by floods, water mains and laterals be extended as rapidly as possible."

"That provision at once be made for the repair and maintenance of macadam pavements. The continuing inspection and repair of this class of construction is absolutely necessary to its existence. The neglect of this work for even a short time will inevitably result in its destruction to the inconvenience of citizens in general and the total loss to the abutting property owners."

"That all stone block pavement at streets be replaced by macadam."

"That in the interest of economy, as well as good service, the city purchase the necessary horses and wagons for this department and make provision for their care."

"That the amount be appropriated each year for the connection of the dead ends of the waterworks distributing system, so that this work be done as soon as possible. The importance of maintaining constant circulation in the water mains cannot be over-estimated. The dead ends act as "mud traps," and the water becomes stagnant and unfit for use in a short time."

"That automatic flush tanks be constructed at all dead ends in the present sewer system."

"That the construction of the reinforced concrete culvert and bridge station at Twelfth South street be pushed to completion before the opening of the irrigation season on April 1 of next year."

"That a concrete flood water by-pass be constructed in Parley's canyon. Your particular attention is called to the condition of the lower end of the old wooden flume, which has served as a flood water by-pass since May, 1897, when a cloudburst destroyed the roadway of the Rio Grande railway track, which the city was obliged to construct at a great expense, and much inconvenience. On account of the construction of the head works of the Parley's canyon conduit at this point, the city is responsible for the maintenance of this flume, and may be called upon to pay heavy damages should any damage accrue to the railway track on account of its neglect."

"That there be established at convenient and suitable points about the city reinforced concrete waterfurnishing mains for the use of animals, such fountains would be cleanly, durable, of pleasing appearance and not particularly expensive."

"That there be established public comfort stations at convenient places about the city."
