Wheeling, W. Va., Oct. 14 .- Judge Taft today concluded his three days campaign in Ohio. What he thinks of the situation is set forth in the following statement which he issued tonight

TAFT'S STATEMENT. "I have now spent three days in the state of Ohio, much of the time in industrial and labor centers.among men who, it was reported, were dis-affected and opposed to the Repub-lican party and its candidates. Wher-ever I appeared I was cordially re-ceived, and only an occasional inter-ruption indicated that misrepresenta-tion of the attitude of the party and the candidates had made a casual im-pression. It is my opinion that the attitude of labor toward the Repub-lican party has been misrepresented as freely as that of the party candidates toward labor, and I find no reason for the belief that la-bor will divide other than on the lines that have heretofore divided it. In my opinion the normal Republican labor vote will be cast as heretofore. "In the agricultural regions it is quite apparent that the farmers are opposed to a change that will imperil their present prosperity.
