One With Rock Island Induces Large Dealing in That Stock.

Some Heavy Transactions. Opening of Market Was a Little Up—Volume of Business Well Distributed—Changes Were Small.

New York, Feb. 4.—Prices opened a fraction all around in the opening dealings in the stock market on a large and well distributed volume of business.

The U. S. Steel stocks were dealt in 1,000 to 2,000 share lots at advances of 1/4 cent. American Locomotive and Tennessee Coal rose large fractions and St. Louis and San Francisco a point. Anaconda gained 1/2. Otherwise the changes were restricted to a small fraction.

The reports of a traffic alliance between the Rock Island and the Union Pacific system has induced large transactions in Rock Island. One one-thousand share block sold at 42 1/2, followed by a 5,000 share block at 42 1/2. The stock reacted to 43 1/2, but night's close. Other movements were irregular.

The Bingham-Centennial company is a recent incorporation and its officers are Rulon S. Wells, president; J. A. Jacobson, vice president and manager; W. B. Douglar, Jr., secretary and treasurer; along with John W. Burton and Phil Maycock, constitute the board of directors.

The company has expended \$2,000 in securing land in addition to doing development work, and it is said, is prepared to go down to a depth of 2,500 feet. BILL OPPOSED BY CHIEF DEVINE

Decries Proposal of Giving Mayor Such Arbitrary Power.

TUDDENHAM IS AGAINST IT.

Both Declare It Would Result in Turning Fire and Police Departments into Political Machines.

The senate judiciary committee met yesterday afternoon to discuss the senate bill that is calculated to give the mayor unrestricted power over the heads of the fire and police departments. James Devine, chief of the fire department, was on hand, and also Councilman Tuddenham, both of whom set forth reasons why the measure, in their judgment, should not pass.

Chief Devine was the first one to take the floor, first calling attention to the fact that some time ago he appointed an assistant chief, the council concurred in his action, but the mayor vetoed it, and he was deprived of the service of one of the most competent men in the department. He declared that the present law was more defective than the one it supplanted, and that the former was repealed because of one unfortunate situation. He said that no city in the country had such a law as the one that is now being proposed and that if the bill becomes a statute, the interests of the fire department would flag, from the chief down, and the city would be presented with the disgusting spectacle of seeing the department positions turned into rewards for ward helders, and corrupt politicians.

He further argued that the public service would inevitably fall if a political pull and not merit were the conditions of appointment and promotion, and that firemen held their positions on the suffrage of one man.

The chief also argued that the mayor was a traitor officer, that he seldom possessed more intelligence than the average citizen, and very often does not care much for the public welfare. He has but a superficial knowledge of the departments, and if given arbitrary power over them, he would be very apt to work havoc. The city council, by all means, should be allowed to hold a check over him.

As to the police department he would not obtrude any remarks, beyond observing that a difficulty in that department, in his judgment, did not warrant a revolution in the law by which both departments are controlled. He said that in Greater New York the last official in the city government could not be removed from office without having charges preferred and proved.

Councilman Tuddenham, said his view of the matter was the same as Chief Devine's. He said that eight men had been selected for enginehouse No. 4, after a most searching examination. "They were rejected by the mayor," declared Mr. Tuddenham, "because he was afraid there were some Democrats among them." He said that the committee, in his opinion, it would be a step backward to pass the bill.
