The Attorney general replied today: "The question to which has received the attention of various courts and upon which there is some conflict of authority. However, the weight of authority is in support of the theory that the sheriff is to be considered as the next in line to succeed to the office. As soon as the new elected officer failing in quality, that in itself would be the cause under which he would be elected. But the sheriff shall be the first to determine what shall have been done and what action he shall take in such case."

In the case of a failure to elect on November 5th, if one of the officers that were elected fails to qualify, the old officer would hold over and that no vacancy would be created."
