On and after August 1st the regular Coal will cost \$2.15 per ton between Salt Lake City and Halfway House in lots of less than 100 bushels, to be supplied by the Company, and \$2.00 per ton when not loaded or unloaded by the Company.

Freight for 100 weight will be received on week days only from 7 a.m. to 10 a.m. and forwarded to Salt Lake City, where it will be taken from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. and will be forwarded the next day.
