DISCOURSE DELIVERED BY ELDER JOSEPH P. SMITH, At the Annual Conference of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, in the New Tabernacle, Salt Lake City, Saturday Afternoon, April 7th, 1876.

REPORTED BY GEO. F. GIBBS. It was with humility, desiring that the spirit of the Lord may rest upon you, my hearers, as well as upon myself, that I arise to address you...

It was said by the Son of God, "Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except ye shall be born again, ye cannot see the kingdom of God." This was said to Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews...

On this particular occasion the Saviour was speaking of Baptism, and in order to impress it upon Nicodemus, that it might be understood by him, as well as by you in all future time, so that people need not be deceived, he spoke thus emphatically on this point of doctrine...
