

BATTLE OF MALAKA.

Fighting Between Cretons and Turks Continued Till Midnight.

TURKISH FORT REDUCED TO ASHES.

The Situation in Macedonia Regarded as a Menace to the Peace of Europe.

CARMA, March 26, 1897. The fighting between Cretons and Turks continued until midnight. During the evening the Cretons burned the Macedonian dwellings and the property of the Cretons. The morning they entered and abandoned the fort at Koriolli. Skirmishing is proceeding about the village of Koriolli outside of Kuma. The Cretons are estimated to have lost 200 men in the fighting around Malak.

DEPARTURE AT ST. PETERSBURG.

St. Petersburg, March 26.—Members of the diplomatic corps here again approached serious complications in Macedonia which will jeopardize the peace of Europe.

Although recognizing that the chief danger lies in that direction, the chief of Great Britain to establish a committee on the Greek frontier in Macedonia and to prevent the outbreak of a civil war, thus aiming to keep the development of complications in Macedonia.
