PROGRAM FOR PRESIDENT'S MISSISSIPPI TRIP.

Washington, Sept. 12.—Gen MacKenzie, chief of engineers, has practically completed arrangements for the trip down the Mississippi river of President Roosevelt and the inland waterway commission next month. It is probable that the president will travel on a special boat and that the commission will be accommodated on another craft. It has been decided to house the commission in the government boat Mississippi, which is the boat employed by the Mississippi river commission on its regular tours of inspection. The light-house tender Lilly has been assigned for the exclusive use of the president and his party, which will be made up of Asst. Secy. Latta, secret service men and representatives of the press associations. The Lilly is under orders to await the president at Keokuk, Iowa, on the 30th inst., though probably the presidential party won't arrive there from Canton before Oct. 1.
