## WOODS CROSS.

## MEETINGHOUSE DEDICATED.

Assembly Rooms of South Bountiful Consecrated to Sacred Service.

Woods Cross, April 29.—The splendid new assembly hall which has just been completed in South Bountiful was dedicated today by President Joseph E. Smith in the presence of a large number of people. Every seat in the building was occupied, and the dedicatory services were very impressive throughout.

Bishop Starns Hatch of South Bountiful ward presided at the meeting. The ward clerk, under Bennett Peterson, rendered some excellent anthems and hymns during the occasion. The other musical parts were a baritone solo, "Just for Today," by Isaac Atkinson, Jr., and an original composition entitled, "Joseph," written and sung by John Robinson of Salt Lake.

President Joseph H. Grant of Davis stake spoke briefly in a congratulatory way, expressing his appreciation of the zealous labors that resulted in the erection of so fine a structure.

President Smith followed with an impressive dedicatory prayer, and later he addressed the congregation for an hour.

The structure dedicated today was commenced in October, 1903. The building has a strikingly beautiful exterior, a magnificent tower, large Gothic windows and broad steps. It is in the form of a cross, and is so constructed that the wings can be used as separate rooms or as a part of the main auditorium. Every one of the 800 that can be seated can see the speaker. The building has a spacious basement, where ward amusements can be held. It is to be electric lighted and steam heated, and each room is fitted with electric light and a telephone. The building is located in the basement. The stairs and upper rooms, as well as the stand, are carpeted. The choir is provided with 40 seats, and the speakers' stand has leather upholstery.

The building and surroundings have cost \$20,151, and are paid for entirely. The people of South Bountiful ward have donated fully four-fifths of the total cost.

Little Frisco Boxer Hammered Denverite Into a State of Helplessness in Short Time.

One of the largest crowds that ever assembled in the Ogden Opera House was present last night and saw Little "Fighting Dick" Hyland of San Francisco knock the "23" sign on William Bothwell of Denver, known as Young Corbett, and one time featherweight champion of the world, in four rounds and a half.
