Correspondence.

Editor Deseret News:

On Saturday and Sunday 15th and 16th inst., meetings were held at Burnham, all of the Santa Fe that locally turning out, and an excellent good time was had.

This settlement is located on the San Juan River, in Rio Arriba Co., N. M., and presided over by Elder Luther C. Burnham, who is composed of ten families of Latter-day Saints, living contiguous to each other, but not all of them on the town site. A good adobe meeting house has been erected that will comfortably seat all the people.

The climate here is all that could be desired, very little cold weather in the winter, and the heat of the summer not on the extreme, some little difficulty has been experienced by early and late frosts, but as the country is settled up, it is expected that these will gradually cease. Corn of the largest varieties will thoroughly mature, melons, cucumbers, squash, tomatoes and almost all classes of vegetables do well. Potatoes do not thrive, as well as in colder climates. It will doubtless prove an excellent fruit country for almost all varieties.

There is quite a large tract of land that can be brought under cultivation by bringing a ditch from the river, which can be done with comparative ease. The land is sandy and warm and of a good quality; the convenient for irrigation, in quantities sufficient for from 50 to 100 families.
