Wednesday, Nov. 10, 1880.

BRIEF TELEGRAMS.

The French Chambers reassembled today.

The *Star* Galia, from Europe, brought 250,000 specie to New York.

Felix Platt, the French editor, has gone to Brussels to avoid imprisonment.

News has reached the India office that up to the 24th of Oct. all was quiet at Kabul.

Garfield will resign his Senatorship in time to have Governor Foster fill the vacancy.

A report has reached Chicago that Kelly has been assassinated in New York, but is not credited.

D. R. Charles, of Barrow, England, has failed, liabilities 250,000. Several Liverpool firms are somewhat involved.

Secretary Ramsey left Washington this morning to attend to some matters of private business. He will return Friday.

A fire in Central City, Dakota, this evening destroyed the American House and contents. Loss \$8,000, uninsured.

The death is announced of Zaimis, the Greek statesman who was many times president of the Council. His death was sudden.

Emigration returns for October, show that 14,000 persons left the United States during the month, principally for the United States.

The report is current that the channel squadron is to be prepared to land a brigade of 2,800 troops at Queenstown, if ordered to do so.

Garfield will not resume his seat in the House next winter, but will remain away from Washington until a few days prior to his inauguration.

Four troops of hussars were dispatched from Dublin for Baltimore by special train this morning. These troops are taken to protect laborers.

The number and value of stamped envelopes and postal cards issued by the P. O. Department during the month of October are the largest known.

The French Government does not intend to enforce the decrees against female congregations as their position will be regulated by other procedure.

General Martinez Campos has had a cordial interview with Marshal Canovas, who told him that he was determined not to leave from his retirement.

A heavy fall of snow is reported in Michigan, today. At Jackson the snow is so heavy the roofs of buildings are caving in under the burden.

Col. E. L. Drake, who drilled the first lot of recruits in Pendennis, and has been the founder of the immense petroleum business, died on Monday.

The advanced and extreme left in the French Chamber of Deputies have approved the proposal for a commission of investigation into Gen. Decles.

The American missionaries at Teheran, Persia, are sheltering and feeding 500 Mussulmans and Christian fugitives in the mission building outside of Urmia.

President Hayes to-day denied that there was a shadow of foundation to the sensational story that an attempt was made to assassinate him in Kansas recently.

The death is announced of Don Jose Maria Orens, Marquis of Alhambra, a Spanish nobleman, who was an advocate of the abolition of slavery in the colonies. He was aged about 80.

A magazine containing a ton and a half of powder exploded in La Crosse, Wis., to-day, by shots fired at the building by two men who were arrested. The explosion was heard 12 miles off.

Johnson, colored, republican in the first Arkansas district, is elected to congress by 1,000 majority. He is a barber and his candidacy was announced but one week before the election.

Delegates representing 50,000 colliers of South Wales and Monmouthshire met to-day in Glamorganshire and resolved to call a conference of all trades to take action with reference to foreign tariffs.

The nihilist trials which have been in progress at Kharokoff, Russia for the last six days, concluded to-day. Three of the accused have been acquitted and four sentenced to various terms of imprisonment.

A correspondent has seen an autograph letter from Gladstone, in which he calls the obstruction offered by successive British governments to Irish reform in Ireland, "a mournful and discreditable record."

The siege of the Abbey of Premonstratensians, at Marcellus, has been raised by the monks neglecting to guard the door by which they communicated with the friars without many friends.

O'Donnell, member of Parliament for Dungarvan, has withdrawn his application for admission to the Land League because he is an American journalist, referred indignantly to the Queen at a recent meeting of the league.
