Oyster Bay, N. Y. March 13.-Former President Roosevelt and Mrs. Roosevelt were the guests of the town of Ovster Bay tonight at a reception held in the town hall,

From 8.30 until 10:30 p. m. Mr. and Mrs. Roosevelt stood behind the justices of the courts and the townspeople shaking hands. Many of the townspeople had not seen their distinguished first citizen since he relinquished is great office and returned here to become a "private citizen of the privatest kind."

Street venders of novelties had early came to town from New York with a hare supply of Roosevelt banners and buttons left over from the 1994 campaign and the 1904 inauguration. They had little trouble in disposing of their wares to the natives, who selzed on the opportunity of securing a last souvenir bearing the president's portrait. Notwithstanding that the reception was to be given for Oyster Bay residents only, many persons from nearby nowns finally secured admission to the ball. Among them were a number who had known Mr. Roosevelt for many years and who felt they were entitled to join his neighbors in the celebration.

For everyone the ex-president had a hearty greeting. Almost every mother in the village brought her calidren, and Mr. Roosevelt was specially pleased to see them.

T've carried the Roosevelt banner in two campaigns, and I hope I shall have the honor of doing so again."

FIGHTING AT SEA.

Mexico City, Sharch 12.—The gunbout Presidente left the port of Acajutta under scaled criters and proceeded to critise along the Nicaraguan coast. Prest Zelaya of Nicaragua, hearing of this, ordered the Momotombo and two other butter of the Salvadows. this, ordered the Momotombo and two other ships to intercept the Salvadoran stemmer. The Presidente was encountered off Corinto, but succeeded in getting into action first and disabled the Momotombo. The latter was compelled to withdraw, and limped back to the port of Corinto. The two vessels accompanying her also withdrew. Hasty repairs was made on the Momotombo, and within a few hours she was ready to put to see action. As she is a faster and better equipped stip than the Presidente it is considered certain she will overtake the Salvadorean gunboat.

HUNDREDS KILLED BY LANDSLIDE IN JAVA

C., March II.—Nous of landslides burying three villages, involving the loss of hundreds of lives, probably over a thousand, in Pendioleo, Java, was brought by the steamer Empress of China. A part of Mount Kentalana fell, eliminating the village of Tigibohaehan and the towns of Wardengsite and Telokhangoss, but one man, one woman and two children estanged to tell the tale. The ground was still everaing when the mail left, tons of earth alimping. Crowds were focking to see the tortible sights, while officials were carrying out the work of recovering the budies, mostly buried deap below tens of citch. The steach was swift and postspine was feared. Dogs and birds were feeding upon the corpuse expassed to view.
