Mr. L. Leroy, who has charge of the dog show, has formulated the following, which has been adopted by the board of directors for the conduct of that feature of the fair:

FIRST ANNUAL UTAH BENCH SHOW to be held under the auspices of the Utah Territorial Fair, October 5 to 10, inclusive. The object of this bench show is to awaken and promote public interest in the agricultural, domestic, and sporting generally, with the proper judging of dogs so as to breeding, symmetry, form, condition and quality, and to afford opportunities for displaying the beauty of the canine race. Bench shows have been attended with good results in other parts of the world, and we hope for similar results here.

The following rules and regulations will be observed during the show, subject to amendment by a majority voice of exhibitors:

All entries must be accompanied by the fee of \$1.00, plus \$1.00 for mounting of specimens to the fair during the show.

This being the first bench show, in the Territory, no premium will be given for the first or second best of pedigree dogs will receive extra credit.

All dogs must be accompanied with a valid certificate of rabies, paid for the expense of the society and otherwise cared for at owner's risk.

All dogs must be brought to the meeting of October 5, at 10 a.m.

No dogs may be entered except an approved specimen, and no dogs may be shown only on mounting for the society.

Owners sending specimens for their dogs must do so at the expense of the society and otherwise care for at owner's risk.

All dogs must be brought to the meeting of October 5, at 10 a.m.

Judges will be selected from among the exhibitors, the owners being excluded.

The decision of the judges must be final to the satisfaction of the show and to the satisfaction of the society, who, in such decisions, shall be final and conclusive in all cases.
