TO IMPROVE FAIR GROUNDS.

City Will Ask Legislature to Fulfill Its Contract.

THE PETITION WILL STATE

that Grounds are Unfitly, and Must be Improved and Parked, or This Will Return to City.

It is learned on good authority that the honorable senators and members of the House of Representatives of the Third Legislature will be petitioned on Wednesday next by the Salt Lake City council, in relation to the condition of the State fair grounds.

At a meeting of the City Council of Salt Lake City, held Jan. 16, President Arthur Barnes and Commissioners John Bidwell and Geo. Buckle were organized as a committee to draw the attention of the Legislature to the very objectionable condition of the grounds and the buildings of the Deseret Agricultural and Manufacturing association in the State fair grounds. In view of the locality of the grounds, the Council will petition the Legislature to abstain from those objectionable conditions. It will be represented by the committee that the Council of this city has repeatedly been petitioned to use its influence in urging the members of the A. & M. society to comply with the terms of the grant, which are as follows:

"Section 1. That the grant provides for the erection of permanent, territorial, ornate fair buildings, for the improvement of the land considerably as a public park. And, Sec. 2. That the grant is to be used for the purpose for which the grant was made, until when cause to be carried out, and the said grounds shall cease to be used for the same purpose, then the said grounds, as specified in the grant, shall be returned to the grantor, that is, to the State fair corporation.

The grant was received Jan. 20, 1869, and it was a trustee's power, page 232 of the county records.

It is clear to the members of the committee that the grant of the grounds has not been complied with. Petitions to the Council have justly claimed that the property of residents taxpayers living in the State fair grounds has increased in value by the unsightly and undesirable condition of the fair grounds.

Attention will be called to the fact that the temporary shacks on the east side of the square are offensive to good taste and a detriment to the fair grounds, and that they are a source of polluting property. Large amounts of unclean property bring here, as it is stated, will not be impressed by the people who come to the fair grounds, but if the present fair-ground improvements and modern comforts be demanded of the members of the community.

The Legislature will be asked to reverse the unsightly and unsanitary condition of the fair grounds.

It is clear that the Legislature will take this matter in hand, since the state has not the slightest interest in visiting the terms of the grant, and of course the Legislature will be asked to reverse its reservation to the city.

The State fair buildings and grounds are situated back of the block between Main and Second Streets, on the west side of the south streets of this city. The square and buildings are worth perhaps \$100,000. The place would be made most attractive, one of the most attractive of public parks.

IT WAS A STATE FUNERAL.

Funeral of the Late Representative Nelson Dingley Viewed by Thousands.

Decorations in the House were Simple and Effective—Superb Floral Tributes.

Washington, Jan. 14.—A state funeral, almost majestic in its impressiveness, was given the late Representative Nelson Dingley at noon today in the House of Representatives, where he had long been such a commanding figure.

The President, his cabinet, distinguished members of the diplomatic corps, members of the Supreme Court, Senate and House and distinguished military and civil life, were ranged along the floor on the day when the body with which he had so long identified would be obtained by care which few excepted him to be entitled to.

He concluded with a fitting tribute to the "dearly beloved husband and father," and the services of the church, the state and the nation he had served.

After the services had been completed, the speaker invited to be present some of them, like a delegation from the New York chamber of commerce, had come from a distance to pay their last tribute of respect to the dead.

At 12 o'clock the late William D. Kelly of Pennsylvania was given a state funeral in the House, during the Fifty-first Congress, when President McKinley was chairman of the House of Representatives, just such an honor being accorded a member of the House. The services were conducted by the hon. Hamilton Fish, the Chaplain of the House, and were borne into the Hall of Representatives by a squad of Marine Guards and a company of the 2nd Artillery.
