LOUISVILLE, Ky., 3.—Willie Russell, who has been a prominent witness against the Owen Co. Ku Klux, and at times deputy U. S. Marshal, was arrested, and by some unknown person, who fired a load of bullets at him through a window.

CINCINNATI, 3.—The Commercial Lexington, Ky., special, says that the celebrated horse Lexington died on Thursday night.

WASHINGTON, 3.—Thomas B. Florence, formerly member of Congress from Pennsylvania, died to-night.

A Centennial Celebration.

BOSTON, 3.—The Centennial Celebration of the signing of the Declaration of Independence of the United States was celebrated at Cambridge to-day; flags were liberally displayed, and many private dwellings were decorated with bunting.

Philadelphia, 3.—Among the passengers by the *Wilmington*, from this port for Bremen to-day, was a delegation representing the Centennial Exposition, on their way to Stuttgart, to take part in the great international shooting match in that city, in August.

MANCHESTER, N. H., 4.—The private residence of Waterman Smith, at Manchester, was destroyed this morning by an incendiary fire, loss \$50,000.

CHRYSTIAN, 4.—McDaniel's theatre and seven business houses on Eddy and 17th streets, were burned to-day by a fire which started at 3:30, and the fire originated in the property room.

Washington, 4.—The postoffice at Williamsburg, Beaver County, Utah, is discontinued.

WESTERN.

SAN FRANCISCO, 3.—Capt. Lindell and Jenn, chief mate of the *May*, by striking a rock and sinking, were arrested yesterday at the instance of the insurance companies, for wilfully wrecking the vessel, and were made a condition charging the captain with approaching him with plans to destroy the vessel, and the design was held to be carried out. The captain and his crew were held to \$50,000. The fire originated in the property room.

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
