The reason of the superiority of the watche made in this country by machinery over the foreign watches made by hand, is self evident. It is an impossibility that the hand should be controlled and guided with the exactness of a machine. In Europe the different parts of a watch are made by different persons, perhaps a hundred miles apart. One whole family, father, mother and children, all engaged in the process of making one of the five wheels of a watch; another family make another wheel, and so on. These different parts are purchased \$20.00. by the Watch-makers, and the watch is put together and made ready for the market. Perhaps it is sent to this country, and after being sold, a part becomes broken, and the watch is useless. It can be taken to a Watch-maker, hands in their construction and repair, it will be a miracle if they are all made with that
