MUST BE SOME MISTAKE.

A MEMBER of the peace has full authority under the law to hold an inquest upon the body of a person supposed to have come to his death by unlawful means. His jurisdiction in such cases within his jurisdiction is as complete as that of the coroner within his county.

If the Justice of the Peace, President has held an inquest upon the body of the man who suddenly died at that place, there is no reason for the coroner's reported attempt to hold an inquest. The coroner's jurisdiction is very plain on this matter, and under the same authority upon Justice as upon coroners as to issuing warrants, empaneling a jury and performing all the duties necessary in such cases. There must surely be some mistake as to the coroner's action, as it is unlikely he would so poorly informed in regard to the law as to do so.
