Coulter was shot and instantly killed by Private Elam, who was a member of an attacking squad sent to quell a riot in the barracks near the fort. Lieut. Hazlehurst was in command of the squad.

Munich, Sept. 23.—Prof. Emmerich asserts that he has confirmed by chemical and spectroscopic analysis the accuracy of his theory that the fatal agent in Asiatic cholera is a specific virus, the formation of which rendered possible by action of the bacilli, the transmission of cholera is now into a virus. The professor says that anybody can now protect himself from fatal consequences of cholera by taking a small amount of his virus, which is only necessary to avoid fatal consequences of cholera and drinking nitrogenous water.
