England Takes Active Steps to Obtain an Explanation.

LONDON, Sept. 4.—The semi-official statement which the Porte issued yesterday regarding the agreement with Russia, touching the passage of the Russian volunteer fleet through the Bosphorus, is unquestioned the Turkish foreign office in its efforts to obtain concerted action on the part of the treaty powers in demanding an explanation of the "Moscow" incident would not affect the existing relations between Britain and Turkey, nor take any action on the part of Great Britain, even if it were to be so interpreted.
