The charge was mainly a recitation of the law governing the case, and occupied about twenty-five minutes. The case went to the jury at 6:15 p.m.

At 11 o'clock the trial in the Curtiss murder trial is still on. It is reported that the jury stands seven for acquittal to five for conviction. The case is now over, very weary and confused, and appears very trying and difficult.
