COMMITTEE REPORTS.

Report of the judiciary committee, reported as follows:

On H. B. 22, bill of city, county and state offices, amended, and recommended its passage.

On substitute for H. B. 24, evidence in felony cases, recommended that it be rejected.

The livestock committee reported H. B. 25, with a recommendation that it pass.

Committee of printing committee, reported a bill for a State printer and fixing the price to be paid.

Gould presented a minority report, opposing in arbitrary fixing the price, as being contrary to good policy in the public interest.

The engineering committee reported that H. B. 16, preventing discrimination against female school teachers was ready for the President's signature.

Miller presented the report of the Capital grounds commission.

BILLS INTRODUCED.

Warren introduced H. B. 26, providing for criminal cases; committee on judiciary.

Warren introduced H. B. 28, requiring certain officers to certify independence of cities, counties and school districts; committee on judiciary.

BILLS PASSED.

H. B. 23, providing for the release of persons held in custody, passed.

OVERTURE DISMISSED.

H. B. 25, discusses in sheep, was taken up and voted passed.

It was referred to the committee on irrigation and agriculture.

Both introduced H. B. 27, a bill to amend section 414, Vol. 2, Compiled Laws of 1888, relating to the laws of judgmental and property committee on judiciary.

H. B. 28, for a State printer, was taken up by the majority and minority reporters. The consideration of the report was in progress at the time the House went to pr.

THE HOUSE.

In the House yesterday afternoon the committee on municipal corporations recommended that H. B. No. 32, for acts creating a board of park commissioners for certain cities and towns in the State of Utah, be not passed. Adopted.

The livestock committee recommended certain amendments to H. B. No. 4, for an act to prevent the sale of forged or fraudulent securities; the amendments were considered in and the bill passed on a vote of 31 ayes, 9 nays, absent 2.

The committee on education recommended the passage of H. B. No. 4, the bill to establish a state normal school, and the bill was referred to the committee on education.

The committee on enrollment reported that they had found H. B. No. 5, amending section 10, chapter 23 of the school laws of 1888, correct, and it was afterwards signed by the speaker in the presence of the House.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS.

H. B. No. 30, by Cannon—An act respecting and extending the powers of the state of the district attorney to make arrests pertaining to the estates of deceased minors, minors and incompetents, persons in times when there is a vacancy in the office of the court, and when he is not absent from the county seat. Passed.

H. B. No. 37, by Hartford (by report)—An act making an appropriation of \$10,000 for the use of the state board of agriculture. Committee on agriculture.

H. B. No. 38, by Logan—An act regarding railroad corporations in making arrangements over their respective roads, when necessary, for public or private purposes. This was temporary withdrawn at the request of the speaker.

H. B. No. 39, by Weller—An act respecting sections 8 and 10, chapter 1, laws of 1888, relating to the giving of the names of cities of the first and second class to the legislature. Committee on agriculture.

H. B. No. 40, by Ferguson, of Ogallala—An act for the protection of title to land in the state of Wyoming from certain oil and gas companies. An amendment was introduced.

The railroads committee reported the return of the bill of H. C. No. 10, relating to the purchase of the railroads of the Legislature, and it was signed by the speaker.
