The Victim an Italian Supposed to Have Killed a Veteran.

A MOB NUMBERING THOUSANDS.

The Corpse Dragged Through the Streets into the Center of the Business Part of the City.

DENVER, July 26.—Last night H. C. Lightfoot, an old Grand Army man, was brutally murdered by a mob, an Italian saloon-keeper of unsavory fame. The murderer was placed in the county jail, and the matter has been discussed all day by the people. Many threats of lynching were made, but not much attention was paid to them, as it was thought the time for frontier justice had passed.

The evening there was a large meeting of unemployed men. There were speeches made on the present financial depression and kindred topics.

When the speakers were through a tall, dark, and rather wearing Grand Army uniform was seen in the crowd and shouted: "Follow me."

The crowd understood him and 2000 people took up the march after him to the county jail. On the way they were joined by many others, and when the jail was reached the mob numbered fully 10,000. Beams and even other available items of building implements were brought into play, and the mobbers surged across the earth and shouting: "Follow me."

The Internal Revenue.

WASHINGTON, July 26.—The preliminary report of the operations of the internal revenue service for the last six years shows the total collections were \$12,450,000, or an increase of \$2,150,000.
