Progress at Orphans' Home—The building of the new Orphans' Home and Day Nursery has been excavated and concrete footings are being put in. The excavation is 100 by 100 feet, and the foundations will be ready by Thanksgiving.

The Farnsworths Return—Hon. P. T. Farnsworth, wife and three daughters, who have been touring Europe, for some months past, were due to sail from Naples to New York on the 5th Inst., which should bring them to this country about the 15th.
