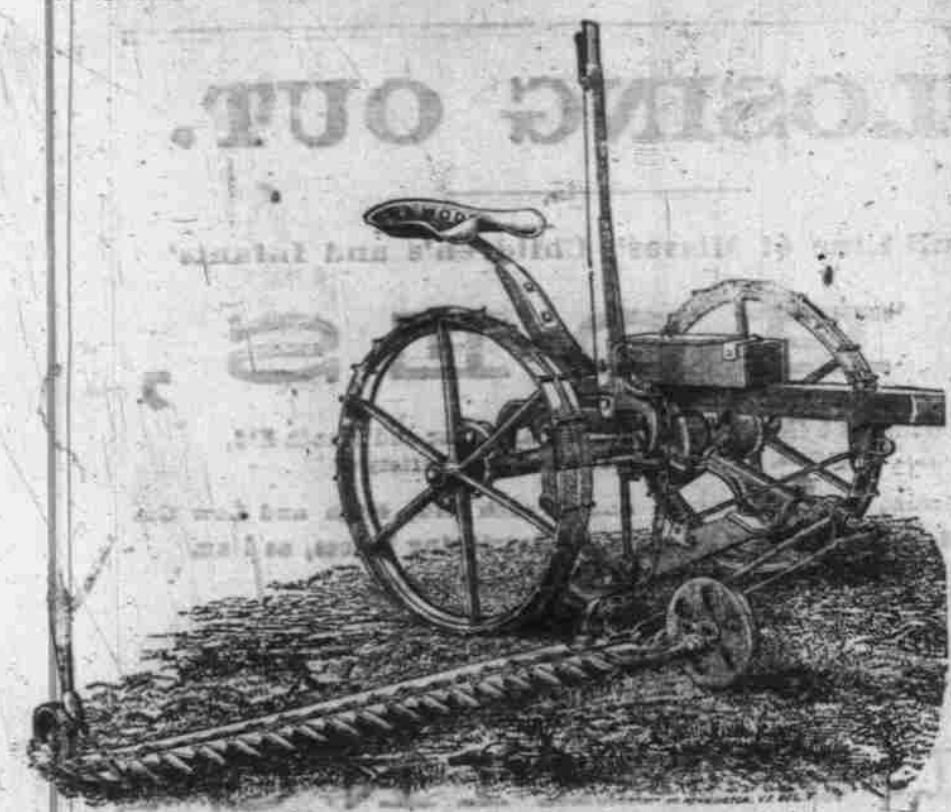

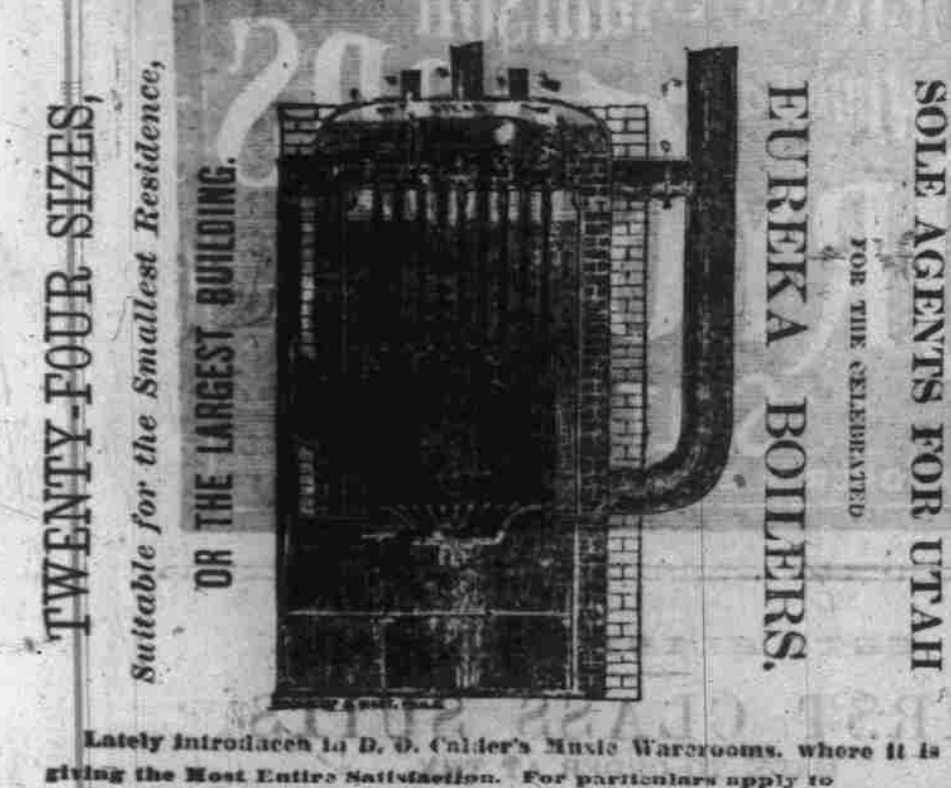

Editor Desert News:
