HE DIED FOR CUBA.

Niger Ogden, a Cornell Student and Noted Football Player.

HE WAS FAITHFUL TO THE LAST.

Death of the Yale in Which the Cornell Player Fell—A Cuban Town Baided.

New York, Dec. 4.—A special to the Herald from Omatima, Camaguey, gives the following details of the death of Major Ogden, the football player, who commanded a Cuban battery during the recent siege of the town of Omatima.

Major Ogden, ordered Major Ogden to open fire upon the Spanish forts. Two hours later a large fort known as Fort Mantua, located on a hill about 700 yards from the town, was abandoned by the defender, who took refuge in the city.

Major Ogden, under heavy fire from the Spaniards was training one of his pieces on the fort, a Mauer ball struck him in the forehead. He fell from the fort, and was found lying on the ground. He was taken to the hospital, but died before he could be removed.
