Democratic Conventions in Various States.

INDIANAPOLIS, 9.—The Democratic State Convention met at 10 o'clock, and was called to order by B. C. Hendricks, governor of the central committee. Hon. Francis B. Hard was chosen temporary Secretary. Congressional districts were then called and committees selected. The committee on resolutions made their report.

The number of emigrants who left from Liverpool in May was 23,192, of whom 7,927 were English, 6,880 Irish, 278 Scotch and the remainder were foreigners. This is an increase over May of last year of 12,064.

The French Chamber of Deputies has fixed as the national fête day the 14th of July—the anniversary of the taking of the Bastille—instead of Imperial day—August 15th.

The Republic Française pronounced strongly for complete amnesty before the 4th.

The senate adopted the bill providing for a convention with the United States settling the indemnity due to Frenchmen from America for damage sustained during the civil war.

A dispatch says: Signor Villa has withdrawn his resignation, seeing that a decisive vote will be taken on Thursday or Friday, on Signor Crispien's interpellation. It will be made a pretext for insisting that ministers are at variance among themselves.

A serious revolution in Buenos Ayres has broken out. The port is blockaded by the national fleet and a state of siege has been declared.
