CREATING THE OFFICE AND RELATING TO THE DUTIES OF CITY MARKET MASTER.

SEC. I. Be it ordained by the City Council of Great Salt Lake City; That the office of City Market Master be and the same is hereby created.

SEC. II. Said Market Master shall be appointed by, and hold his office during the pleasure of the City Council, and shall, before entering upon the duties thereof, take and subscribe an oath, and give bonds, with sureties, to the satisfaction of the City Recorder, for the faithful performance of his duties as hereinafter provided, and said bonds shall be filed in the Recordor's office.

BEC. III. It shall be the duty of the City Market Master to attend to leasing the stalls in said Market, under the direction of said Council, and to collect the rents agreed upon therefor, and he shall see that the said Market shall be open to the public such hours as shall be deter-

mined by the City Council.
SEC. IV. He shall see that all rules and regulations adopted by the said Council, applicable to said Market, are carefully observed by all persons leasing or occupying stalls therein; and shall report any violation or infringement thereof, that shall come under his observation, to the Mayor or other officer having jurisdiction, to the end that any regulations necessary may be enforced. And it shall turther be his duty to use all proper or lawful means to suppress drunkenness and profanity in said Mar-

SEC. V. The City Market Master is hereby authorized and empowered to have general supervision of the Market House, and enforce all such regulations as he may deem necessary to promote the public good and to preserve or-der and cleanliness in and about said Market. D. H. WELLS, Mayor.

AN ORDINANCE.

RELATING TO THE CITY MARKET.

SEC. I. Be it ordained by the City Council of Great Salt Lake City; That the Market House, situated on First South Street, between East and West Temple streets, shall be known as the City Market.

SEC. II. The stalls in said Market shall be numbered, commencing at the south east corner, alternately from left to right towards the west, and in leasing, they shall be designated

SEC. III. Said stalls shall be leased by the City Market Master, as directed by the City Council, on such terms and for such time as by the Market Master and the party or parties leasing may be agreed upon. All rents shall be payable in advance to the Market Master, who shall immediately pay the same into the City Treasury, and no lease shall be transferable. nor can any other party occupy under it, except by permission of the Mayor or City Council.

SEC. IV. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons, renting or occupying a stall or stalls in said Market, to place, or suffer to be placed within the limits thereof, any offal, dirt, filth, or unwholesome matter; or keep, sell, or offer for sale, any meat or other article of provisions which shall be tainted, diseased, or corrupted so as to be offensive or unwholesome; or suffer the main alley in front of their stall to be obstructed with any manner of vehicle, truck or other thing that shall interrupt a free passage through the same.

SEC. V. All persons leasing or occupying stalls in said Market are hereby required to comply with the foregoing rules and regulations, and all such other regulations as may be made and adopted by the City Council, for the good order, cleanliness and management thereof; and any person violating or refusing to comply with any of the said regulations or provisions, shall be liable to be fined in any sum not less than one dollar nor more than one hundred dollars for each offence, or forfeiture of his lease, or both, at the discretion of the Court.
