"MORMONS" IN WESTERN VIRGINIA.—The Wheeling (Va.) Intelligencer says: We learn that there is in the town of South Wheeling a society of Mormons who practice all the doctrines of that sect except that of polygamy. We have had a conversation with an Englishman who belongs to the society, and who firmly believes in all the peculiar notions of the Latter-day Saints. He says he was converted to the faith since his arrival in this country. In his opinion all the churches to which Gentiles usually attach themselves are wonderfully corrupt. He has not had a physician in his house for five or six years. Cases of sickness are cured by anointing and laying on of hands, according to the customs of the New Testament.

By this time the Virginia "Mormons" will have learned that delays are dangerous. It is a bad thing to be too fast; but there are cases when too slow is infinitely worse. If there are any of the Saints away down South, they will be able, we expect, to estimate now the counsels of former days. Had they listened to the "Still Small Voice," the counsellor, they would have escaped the desolating scourge of war.

AN ORDINANCE

Amending an Ordinance entitled An Ordinance in relation to Crimes and Punishments.

BE it ordained by the City Council of Great Salt Lake City, that Section 22, of "An Ordinance in relation to Crimes and Punishments," passed March 16th, 1860, be amended by striking out the whole of said Section, and inserting in lieu thereof the following, to wit: Any person or persons (except those lawfully authorized) tearing down, mutilating or otherwise defacing any Ordinance, Bill, Poster, Advertisement, or other paper of a business or legitimate character, posted up within the limits of this City by any public officer or any other person or persons whomsoever, shall be liable to a fine of not less than one, nor more than fifty dollars for every such offence; one half to go to the person or persons giving information of such breach of Ordinance, or, the offender may be punished by imprisonment for a term not to exceed twenty days.
