After the meet over this afternoon, the visitors will give a dance and everything possible will be done to make them feel they are welcome to Salt Lake.

The list of events, names of officials and results will be published in last evening's "News." The events now being run off are as follows:

100 yards dash, 220 yards, 880 yards, 440 yards and mile run. The hurdles are 120 and 140.

Then comes the broad jump, the shot put, pole vault, hammer throw and relay race. Each team expects to win a number of these events, and the result will be watched with interest by a large crowd of students.
