How to Correct Wrinkles.

WHILE the fibrous portion of the skin becomes relaxed and loses its elasticity, the outer covering becomes flabby. Very often flabby skin is due to the mistake made of greasing the skin too much. It is not so flabby, for the best treatment the sensibility of the nerves and removal of elastic fibers of the skin to give them power of contracting. To avoid flaking skin through washing the face, use a pure olive oil soap with warm, not hot, water. Wash the face with the soap, then with water.
