CONGRESSIONAL.

SENATE.

WASHINGTON, 2.—Burnside called up, as a special order, the bill to remove all restrictions now existing in regard to the enlistment of soldiers in the army of the United States. The bill was read, and an amendment proposed by Blaine, that hereafter colored men shall have full right to enlist in all arms of the service. The railroad funding bill came up as an unfinished business, and Mr. Blair addressed the Senate in support of the judiciary committee bill.

A discussion sprang up from this, which was participated in by Thurman, Mr. Edmunds, and Mr. Blair. The bill was then passed.

After an executive session, the Senate adjourned.

HOUSE.

WASHINGTON, 2.—Saylor reported the bill to prevent default or delay in the payment of interest on the 3.55 District of Columbia bonds. Referred to the committee of the whole.

A joint resolution was reported, authorizing the committee having in charge the Washington monument to apply the \$30,000 to giving greater stability to the foundation.

Cox moved to lay the bill on the table. Defeated, 51 to 38. The bill then passed.

It was voted, yes 148, no 79, to take up for consideration the report of the committee on the bill to reform in regard to the case of door-keeper Polk.

Harrison explained the report. He said the bill was intended to reform, and would go before the committee on Monday.

He said he would not support the bill, but would support the committee's report.

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
