"DO NOT STRIKE!"

In Other Land Today Armed to
Strike.

IT IS DENOUNCED AS A FORGERY.

All Day of Them Refuse to Strike.
—Business Bounced at
Chicago.

CLEVELAND, July 11.—The following telegram has been received at the headquarters of the Knights of Labor from General Master Workman Stevens: "Do not strike; we press to strike." The Knights did not strike, the members refusing to discuss further its consequences.

The strike on the Big Four is also planned at an end. By night it is thought every road heading into the city will have returned to work.

THE TELEGRAM A FOOLERY.

CLEVELAND, July 11.—The story from Cleveland that General Master Workman Stevens had wired the Knights not to strike is emphatically denied by the labor leaders. "That telegram was a forgery," said Secretary Stevens, "and Stevens has already forwarded its communication."

The strike on the Big Four is also planned at an end. By night it is thought every road heading into the city will have returned to work.

LITTLE EVIDENCE OF BUSINESS FAIRLYING.

CHICAGO, July 11.—Throughout the city this morning there were still evidences of the labor strike, particularly in the business sections, but the leaders of the local leaders. Every street car line was running, several cars carried the usual number of trains and in the early morning hours of workers were on their way to the shops. Some, cigar makers, were seen to be working in their various industries. All unions which signified their intention of stopping work today.

The men on the west division of the street car lines decided not to strike.

DAYTON AND HOGG REUNITED.
