## AN EASIER FEELING.

The Worst Riots Thought to Be  
Over in Chicago.

## ENGAGEMENTS DURING THE NIGHT.

Grand Army Veterans Offer Their Ser-  
vices—President Cleveland's Dis-  
cretion Discussed.

CHICAGO, July 9.—At 10:15 a.m.,  
everything was quiet and the feeling  
was growing that there would be no  
more serious rioting.

The roads are all moving passenger  
trains and a number are moving  
freight. It is quite clear that the  
riots yesterday were composed chiefly  
of fires from the packing houses and  
not very serious meet men, but  
President Cleveland's proclamation  
and the order of President Davis to his  
followers to avoid any lawlessness seem  
to have been very effective.

### THE NIGHT'S ROME.

WASHINGTON, July 9.—General  
Baldwin, commanding general of a dis-  
patch train General Miles, stating that  
he had two engagements during  
the night between the troops and  
the mob at Hammond, and several  
troops had been killed and many  
wounded.

### THE LABOR CONFERENCE.

CHICAGO, July 9.—The conference  
of labor leaders occupied the whole  
night. The Hammond speeches were

and others, and the conference was  
supposed to endeavor to induce

some arrangement could be made.  
When a truce was agreed upon, it was  
arranged to be bound by the order.

sufficient protection to run stock trains  
in and out of the yards. The receipts  
today were 11,300 and lambs and  
sheep.

EXPERIMENT IN IDAHO.

Ortige of the Troubles Which Resulted  
to the Murder of Koenig.

WALLACE, Idaho, July 9.—The  
troubling trouble which followed the killing

of John Koenig, a blacksmith at the  
Gow mine, on July 8, originated in  
his giving damaging testimony against  
the strikers in trial for robbing him  
two years ago. The month ago he  
had been released after being accused  
of being the miners' union of Gow  
and Burke, and their employees were  
required to discharge them. The  
mine owners raised stock, discharged  
or protected them, allowing them to  
work again. Both sides were equally  
aligned, and a miners' strike was  
declared. On July 8, Koenig, armed  
with a shotgun, rode with his wife  
and children to the town of Gow and  
Koonee. Other men whom they saw  
in the mines and mills were  
warned and bid themselves. They  
had been told to leave, and when  
they refused, both sides armed  
and marched toward the Moxiean  
mine, where they made them leave  
and never return to the Gow & Koonee  
country, and left them. Their  
families remained at Gow and Burke,  
however, the difficulties of their  
wives against the assessors, nothing  
else has been done toward their arrest, al-  
though the crime was witnessed by at  
least 150 people.

Gouverneur McCusker offers \$1,000 for

There have been in condition of  
suspense and distrust for the past four  
days, no other threats have been made.

Every citizen is taking precautions for  
his own protection. All the mines  
are under martial law, and these  
are likely to close. An attempt  
was made to blow up the Bunker Hill  
Electric power house yesterday morning,  
but it failed only because the bomb  
struck a stump and it exploded near  
the building instead of under it as  
was intended.
