TWO YEARS FOR KELLER. Chicago, July 8.—Daniel F, Keeler, formerly a captain in the United States army, recently convicted of defrauding the government through the use of stolen quartermaster's checks, was to-day sentenced to serve two years at hard labor in the federal prison at Leavenworth, Kan. Keller was alleg-ed to have taken the bank checks at Fort Sheridan and to have forged and cashed them in Reno, Nev., to the ex-tent of \$7,000. He was arrested at Kamloops, B. C.

MURDER OR SUICIDE?

MURDER OR SUICIDF? New York, July 8.—As a result of a mysterious shooting today at Maspath, L. L. Chusen Wabalk, a wholesale grocer, lies dead at his home and the police are searching for some clew for what they believe is a murder. Wabalk returned to his home at an early hour today with a party of friends, and re-tired to his room, his wife not hear-ing him enter the house. Soon after-wards his wife was awakened by a pis-tol shot and, rushing into his room, found him unconscious with a bullet hole in his right temple, from which he died a few minutes later. A fully loaded revolver was found under his pillow and not a cartridge had been exploded. The motive for the crime is a mystery.
