

NEXT WEEK IN HISTORY.

JULY 8.
1807—Emperor Napoleon I of France and Emperor Alexander I of Russia concluded a treaty of peace at Tilsit, on the river Nieman, as a result of the French victory over the Russians at Friedland June 14, 1807. By this treaty Napoleon and the czar practically divided the mastery of Europe between them. The legitimacy of the crown which Napoleon had assumed and of the crown he had placed upon the heads of his brothers was recognized by this treaty.
1857—Prince Ferdinand of Saxe-Coburg-Gotha was elected prince ruler of Bulgaria.
1893—Justice Samuel Blatchford of the United States supreme court died at Newport, R. I.; born 1829.
1906—George L. W. capitalist and promoter, son of George Law of Panama fame, died in New York city; born 2449.

JULY 7.
1758—General Abercrombie attacked Ticonderoga, with 15,000 men and was repulsed with a loss of 2,500.
1780—Fitz-Greene Halleck, poet, was born in Guilford, Conn.; died there 1857.
1822—Percy Bysshe Shelley was drowned in the bay of Spezia, born 1792. The circumstances of Shelley's death were peculiarly tragic.

1767—John Quincy Adams, sixth president of the United States, born at Braintree, Mass.; died 1848.

1774—Sir William Johnson, famous pioneer and Indian manager, died near Johnstown, N. Y.; born in Ireland, 1715.

1886—Ernest Curtius, LL. D., a well known German Hellenist, died in Berlin; born 1814.
1898—Bombardment of Santiago by the American land and naval batteries concluded; last gun of the campaign fired.

1830—Gen. John Charles Fremont, explorer, soldier and Republican presidential candidate in 1856, died in New York; born in Georgia in 1813. Fremont had held the rank of lieutenant in the United States army and became famous as the "Pathfinder." His explorations across the Rocky mountains, in 1841, were of great importance in civil life.
1900—The allied forces at Tientsin repulsed in a desperate attack upon the native city.
1906—Capt. Alfred Dreyfus restored to his rank in the French army by a special act of the legislature.
