The funeral will be from the Ninth Ward school house on Wednesday, at 10 a. m. Friends are invited.

In Salt Lake City, July 24th, 1882, from ovarian tumor, JANE TODD, of West Weber, Weber County, Utah.

Sister Todd was born in South Church, Durham, England, June 23d, 1843, emigrated to Utah October 23d, 1881. She was a faithful Latter-day Saint; was well known to many of the Elders who labored in the English mission, to whom her house and home were always open. She died in full faith of the Gospel and in sure and certain hope of a joyful resurrection with the just. She leaves an aged mother and two daughters to mourn her departure.

At Hamble, Southampton, May 31, 1882, SARAH QUINTON, wife of James Quinton; born June 4, 1822; aged 60 years lacking 4 days. Was a good Latter-day Saint.—Mill Star.

At his residence April 3d, 1882, in Spring Lake, Utah County, of paralysis, WILLIAM GREENHALGH. Deceased was born July 29th, 1811, Lancashire, England. Was baptized October, 1840, emigrated to Nauvoo in 1842, labored on the Temple there under great privations, receiving his endowment therein; belonged to the 14th Quorum of Seventies; suffered with the Saints in being robbed and driven from their homes, at the mouth of the enemy's cannon; came to Utah in 1852. In the general move south in 1858, he came to Santaquin, where he resided until 1880, when he removed to Spring Lake. He was always in concert with the active priesthood, laboring as a teacher; being in fact a peacemaker and laborer for Zion. He died as he lived, a true and faithful Latter-day Saint, whose loss is lamented by family and friends.—[COM.]

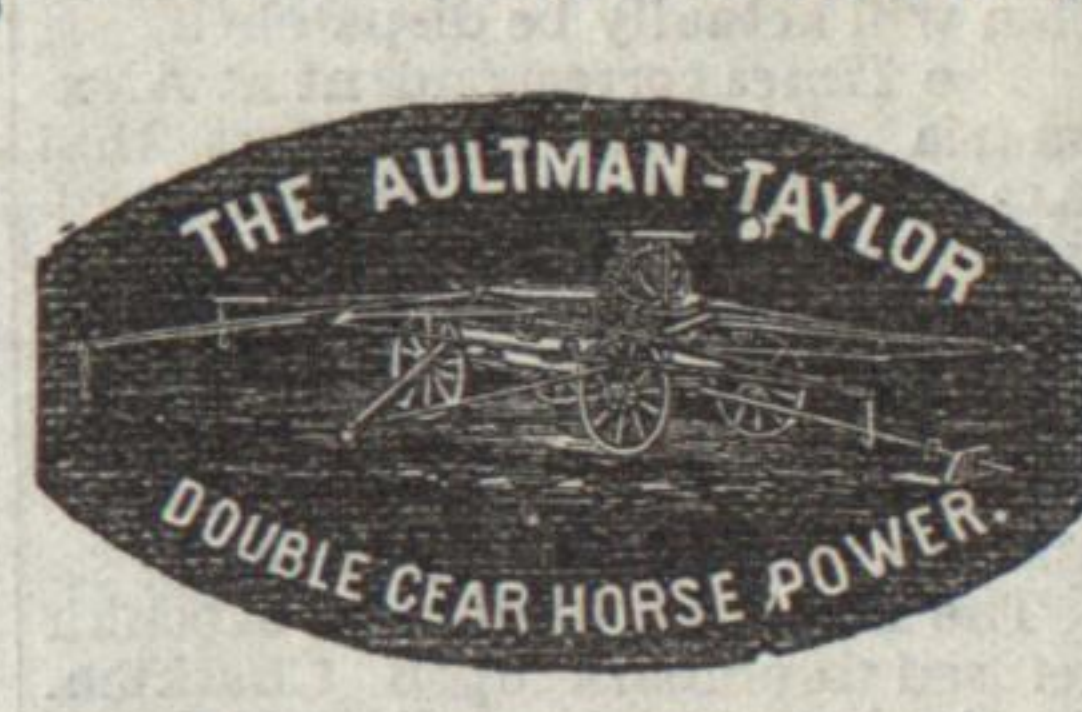
