LETTER FROM MILBURN.
 The First Passenger Train to Indian-Remains from the Blackhawk War—Present Population of Tullahoma Valley.

The reader may ask, What and where is Milburn? It is a small village, a precinct of Sanpete County, and a ward of the Sanpete Stake of Zion, organized on the 20th of April, 1850, with James W. Stewart as Bishop and William E. Stewart as Elder and P. C. Jensen as his second Counselor. The ward contains twenty-three families, and the village of Milburn has a most beautiful and romantic location on rising ground near the mouth of Dry Creek Canyon, about a mile east of the Sanpete Stake office north of Fairview and about seven miles northwest of Indian, in Tullahoma Valley. The Sanpete Stake of the Rio Grande Western Railway is being built through the farming land below the village, the track being laid already to the extent of about the station to the west of the village.
