

BRADY ON LOCAL OPTION

Republican Candidate Gives His Views At Payette Meeting.

(Special to the "News.")

Payette, Idaho, Oct. 31.—This city today was the hotbed of politics and virtually marked the windup of the political campaign in the state of Idaho. Hon. M. Alexander, the Democratic candidate for governor, addressed a noonday meeting in the opera house,

well attended by Democrats, and tonight Hon. James H. Brady virtually ended his state campaign by addressing the largest political gathering ever assembled in this place.

At the suggestion of Chairman A. B. Moss, it was decided to make the meeting an open air one, as the crowd was too great for the hall. Those present besides Chairman Moss and Mr. Brady, were ex-Mayor Cleare of Pocatello, Col. Patch of the Second I. N. Guard, B. P. Shawhan, Payette's candidate for the state legislature, Chairman Moss paid a tribute to Mr. Brady both as a business man and a citizen, and also made emphatic reference to

the charges made against him personally by Mr. Alexander. Col. Patch, Candidate Shawhan, and Mr. Cleare also spoke, the latter paying special tribute to Mr. Brady, and in the part he had taken in the rebuilding of the state.

Mr. Brady had an enthusiastic reception, the greatest interest being attached to his remarks on the liquor question. On this point he said: "I am now and always have been in favor of local option. Each county should arrange its liquor question to suit itself. Years ago I became convinced on this matter back in Kansas." So declared the speaker. Continuing

he stated he had never had occasion to change his mind, having taken his position through the teachings of his Sunday school teacher, St. John, the noted Prohibitionist and ex-governor of Kansas.

"I give you my solemn promise as citizens and voters to perform every promise I have made during this campaign and to faithfully uphold and carry out every plank incorporated in the platform of true Republicanism," said Mr. Brady. "These are not idle words I am uttering tonight. I am sincere from the bottom of my heart. I consider every promise given sacred. If I am elected governor of the great

state of Idaho at the polls on next Tuesday, I shall deem myself the humblest of humble servants of the great people of this great young state, and my every effort while its chief executive will be with the end in view to the highest ideals for the advancement of this state in its place among other states in this great union and for the advancement of the men and women of Idaho."

Mr. Brady's eulogy of Roosevelt and Taft also drew immense applause. The air was chilly but the crowd remained to the end.

Before the meeting Payette Republicans paraded the streets with torch-
