

TELEGRAPHIC. PREPARING FOR WAR

ARMED Activity in the Government
Dockyards of Spain.

DURING THE ATLANTIC STEAMERS:
Arrived from the United States Government
Cruiser *Frankland* now
at Madrid.

KASER, Oct. 10.—It is reported
that the best authority, that the
Spanish government has notified the
Spanish minister at Washington that
a necessary for Spain to act precipi-
tately in closing the Cuban insurrec-
tion, has caused a profound ant-
agonism.

MADRID, Oct. 10.—It has been noticed
recently that there is quite unusual
activity in the government dockyards at

troops in the Spanish Caribbean

Commissioner Bowring's Speech.
Hon. George D. Campbell, Oct. 10.—After
having opened court this morning,
Judge Duffie asked for Sheriff Knapp.
Judge Duffie stated to him that
he was not satisfied and believed that
the sheriff had not done his duty.
Court recessed until 1 P.M. Mr. Knapp,
and that he wished to call no
attention to the fact that in doing so
the principal would be breaking the
laws of the state and outraging the
dignity of the state. A. C. Cooley, He-
ctor, in conjunction with Judge
Cooley, the prosecuting attorney, in-
formed the sheriff at what stage it was
necessary to interfere. The Judge then
stated to Mr. Knapp that he had a
right to call the police authorities, and
that he was in violation of the law for
a citizen so called upon to return to re-
quest protection.

Gov. Atkinson's Speech.
SPRINGFIELD, Ill., Oct. 10.—Gov.
Atkinson stated that Secretary of State
Harrison had no authority to
recommend him as a candidate for
re-election as governor.
The governor says he is not a can-
didate and does not know whether he
will be.

CHRISTIANS KILLED IN CHINA.
Mission Station at Nan Ching De-
stroyed and Clergymen Murdered.
London, Oct. 10.—Paris dispatch
states that nearly forty mission houses were de-
stroyed and many lives lost. All of the
missionaries, including nineteen
Frenchmen and one American, who
had been captured, are safe. The
missionaries are ruined east
of Lo-Pan across the gulf at Chung-
king. Several houses were wrecked
and many killed. The single plan-
tation on one side was destroyed
and destroyed. Further news
was awaited. At least two several houses
were damaged. Clergymen and clerks
were killed. Many missionaries many
were slain.

The scenes of carnage at Tungchouping
were going around. The whole
country around the river and Nao
Nao was overflowed and im-

THE SCENE OF THE WRECK.

The Loss of the Spanish Cruiser *Cristobal Colon*.

MARINA, Oct. 10.—Admiral Gomes
y Marques has this morning from
the Colorado Roads, the scene of the
wreck of the Spanish cruiser *Cristobal Colon*. He confirmed the details pre-
viously given by the Associated Press,
stating that on September 29th, the
cruiser was in the western extremity
of the Indian ocean, and with
the Colorado Roads. As
night approached the weather deve-
loped like a regular cyclone and the
wind and waves held out to sea. In
addition, effects, owing to the
local currents, were unable to make
any observations. Owing to this, they were
in favor of attempting to run along
the coast of Africa. And, make
Cape Agulhas, where were two opinions

tempt to cross the Indian ocean. The majority,
however, thought it better to run
out to the west off the coast of Africa.
But the greater resources, however,
had been used, and shortly after midday

A Turkish Patriotic Party

London, Oct. 10.—The Constitutional

Party, is far from dead. While the Armenians and
others of the Christian population
are in a state of effervescence,
which is causing the Turks much anxiety
and alarm, the party is still active.
In fact, it is more active than ever.
A meeting was held at the church of St. George
against the standard party, which
party is seriously predic-
ting its general opposition to exclusive
rule against the sultan, who it de-

clares to be primarily responsible for
the present state of affairs.

The principal fear at the palace
arises not from the Armenians, but
from the revolutionary spirit displayed
by the Moslems. The latter will almost
surely, before the end of the year,
have won every reason to believe that
they will be enabled to accomplish
before the end of the week.
