Debates of Congress in for Weeks
Other than Work.

HOW OFFICES ARE DISTRIBUTED.

The Hawaiian Ex-Queen Will Not Be
Received by the Throne—The
Instituted Banks.

DISSENT NAME BUREAU.

Washington, D. C., Jan. 15.—The
coming two weeks will be devoted to words rather than
work by both Houses of Congress.
The tariff amendment discussion
over the last Wednesday, with small
success and free debate is the program
of the House. The adjournment bill and
the Hawaiian matter will occupy the
attention of the Senate.

Hurricane is expected to blow during

already filed with the clerk of the committee on ways and means,
who will probably offer and introduce
several. None others are likely to be
adopted.

The internal revenue bill will be
referred on Thursday. The friends of

The treasury agencies will probably
win by the separation of the tariff
from the internal revenue bill.

Washington, D. C., Jan. 15.—Chairman
McCarthy, of the House committee
on foreign affairs, and Representative
Holloman, of Cal., called the
committee on ways and means, which
would be in session on the subject
of the Hawaiian problem. After some
time Mr. McCarthy said: "The question
as to whether will be submitted to
the House before January 1st." He
then added: "I will not present any
amendment, nor the members
of the foreign affairs committee are
acting very fully, trying to solve the
problem. One thing we can say is
that the bill is not at all anomalous
only in the executive but Congressional
circle. It will never be
likely to be adopted."

THE HOUSE.

Washington, D. C., Jan. 15.—On
motion of Capt. Tamm, the Senate
bill authorizing the Arkansas Pass Har-
bor Co. of Texas, from the time im-
plementation of the act of 1850, as to improvements
of Arkansas Pass, was passed
before the House, without much
debate, excepting the words for the
admission of the tariff bill.
