## TURKISH MEASURES.

### Military Preparations on the Greek Frontier.

SAID TO BE FOR DEFENSE ONLY.

Threats the Scene of Disorder—State Exchanged Between Greeks and Turks.

CONSTANTINOPLE, Feb. 17.—(Copyrighted by the Associated Press.)—The council of ministers yesterday has decided to leave the reinforcement of Crete to the powers. The council also decided to send Karadimitris to Crete as imperial high commissioner and to adopt military measures on the Greek frontier, previously intimated, to appoint Marshal Edhem Pasha, who directed operations against the insurgents of Zolton in 1900, to command the Turkish troops on the frontier and call out the first reserve and the third army corps now at Salonika. These measures, however, are for purely defensive purposes in order to enable the Turkish government to be prepared for all eventualities.

The council has informed the ambassadors of the powers that in view of the aggressive attitude of Greece in the Balkans, it has decided to adopt measures required by the situation. The council took a decision to express its satisfaction at the handling of settlements of matters at Athens.

In spite of the powerful outlook it is known that the debasement of Greek money on Crete caused great sensation at the Villa Kioni and it required the use of much tact to quiet the minds of the ambassadors on the point to accept the situation.

Anti-Turkish demonstrations are reported to have occurred at Athens and Thessalonika, where lawless hordes of rioters have been seen. It is reported that no further trouble will occur, although the Greek troops are gathering near the frontier.

NOTICE TO A GREEK CONSUL.

CAIRO, Feb. 17.—There was a meeting of the committee of the Egyptian Society today on the Italian frontier. It was resolved to take steps to bring about a more peaceful state of affairs on Crete.

A joint note was drawn up and sent by Admiral Cresswell, the Italian commander of the Mediterranean fleet, to the Turkish and Greek governments, stating that the Italian fleet was in the Mediterranean for the purpose of maintaining peace and order.
