They have the peculiar octagonal shape of crystallized quartz, and their size varies from that of a pin's head downwards.

It has been observed throughout Central and Western Europe, where criminal statistics are classified according to the religion of the prisoners, that there are proportionately less Jews convicted than members of other denominations.

San Francisco can claim to have the greatest variety of religious worship of any city in the land. Not only has it a Chinese temple, but a Greek church began its service there on the last Tuesday in August. There are about one thousand members of this Church in California, emigrants from Russia. Their number will doubtless increase from Alaska, where the Greek religion prevails.

German papers state that the whole tract on which the city of St. Petersburg is built is sinking slowly, but with fearful regularity, and that at the present rate it will be wholly submerged in fifty years. It is added that the Russian Government is taking steps to remove the court to some other city.

The shrill whistle of the railway engine is soon to be heard in Ferris. It has been granted to a company of English capitalists the exclusive right to construct railways in the country for a period of twenty years. These capitalists begin operations with a short road, extending from the capital to the suburban village of Ray, a famous weekly resort of pious Teheranians. Ground has been broken and the engineer employed estimates that the line can be constructed and stocked for less than \$500,000, on which the passenger traffic of some forty thousand devotees a week will, he reckons, yield a remunerative dividend, exclusive of an 8 per cent.
