

## THE SCHOOL ELECTION.

The Nominations for Trustees Finished Last Night.

## POLITICS IN THE FIRST PRECINCT.

A Non-Partisan and a Liberal Nominees to be Voted for, to Succeed Harry E. Duke.

The nominations for school trustees for the five municipal wards of the city were finished last night.

## First Precinct.

Determined to carry partisanship and politics into the school election, the Liberals of the First precinct nominated A. J. Pendleton, Jr., to succeed Harry E. Duke, who declined postively to accept a nomination.

The Republicans met in the exposition building and nominated J. J. Thomas for the office. Later the Democrats endorsed the nomination and state their reasons why in an address issued to the voters of that precinct.

## Second Precinct.

In the Second precinct a few Liberals held a meeting at the Union hotel, presided over by G. M. Jackson. K. C. Harrington acted as secretary. Fred Leonard nominated Colonel Nelson to succeed Harry as trustee from the Second precinct. There was no opposition and the nomination was unanimous.

## Third Precinct.

There was a large and harmonious gathering of Third precinct voters in the hall of the First National Bank. The ward mouse had voted to select a candidate to succeed W. J. Newman, retiring trustee for that precinct. A. S. Geddes acted as chairman and R. P. Morris as recorder. A committee consisting of W. E. Hines, A. H. Myrick, John Phipps, G. H. Hardy and J. L. Cook was appointed to present the name of a candidate, and after five minutes' deliberation Mr. Hyde reported that the committee was unanimously in favor of Walter J. Hines.

The nomination was made unanimous.

## Fourth Precinct.

The Fourth precinct voters held a thoroughly non-partisan meeting several nights ago and nominated Lieut. Richard W. Young to succeed himself as reported in these columns the following day.

## Fifth Precinct.

The Liberals of the Fifth precinct held a meeting in the municipal court room in the City Hall. Councilman Beardley was chosen chairman and A. C. Ross secretary.

J. E. Dooly was unanimously chosen to succeed himself, after which the meeting adjourned.
