

Will Cost More Than a Million a Year

Mr. Gascon stated that the expense of his work would be approximately \$200 for the one month. Dr. Ward, who, as the city's chief health official, will have full charge of sanitary and hospital work, said he would require about \$45,000 a month.

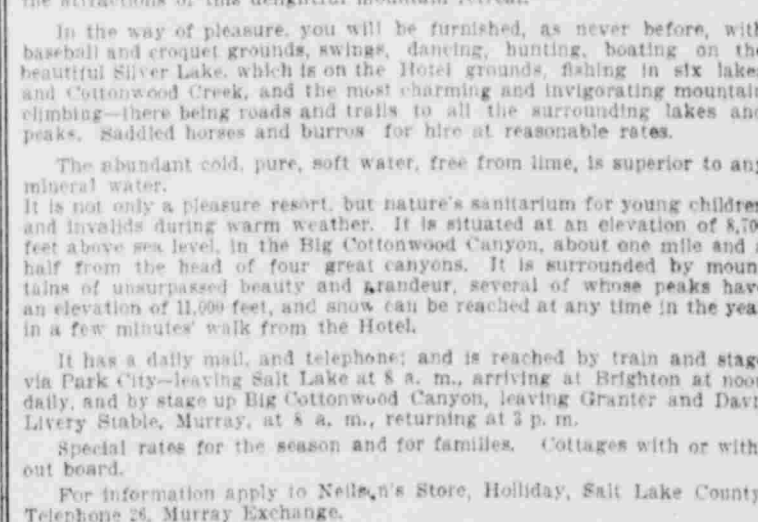
